## Fitting the MOUSebean® Hand Rest Coupling

If you use the supplied coupling, it must be positioned at the correct height on the mouse.

The slider must move freely in and out, especially when you move the mouse with your fingers and the heel of your hand stays fixed on the hand rest.

To get the maximum comfort and benefit from the MouseBer Hand Rest, follow these simple steps to ensure you fit the coupling properly and in the correct position.



## How to Fit the Coupling to the Mouse

- Clean the rear of the mouse and the socket flaps with alcohol and let them dry.
   All surfaces must be clean and dry for maximum adhesion.
- 2. Choose a flat, level surface.
- Pull the slider out from the hand rest and position it centrally behind the mouse.
- 4. At the point where the end of the slider touches the mouse, draw a small pencil mark (see fig. 1). This should be 9mm above the surface of the mouse pad (the mouse may tend to lift if the socket is too low).
- Carefully follow the manufacturer's instructions and apply a few tiny drops of superglue (cyanoacrylate adhesive) to each socket flap.
- Carefully align the socket hole over the pencil mark then
  press the flaps firmly onto the mouse until the glue is set.
  The adhesive might be strong enough to use but will only reach full
  strength after a few hours.
- 7. Pull the slider out from the hand rest and push the end into the socket.

## Removing the Hand Rest from the Coupling

- 1. Gently move the hand rest away from the mouse so that the slider is fully extended.
- Gently lift and peel one corner of the socket away from the slider with your thumb and withdraw the hand rest.
- 3. For protection, the slider can be pushed all the way in until it clicks.
